Dear Parents

In November the children in Year 6 will be visiting the War Memorial, in front of the Harlington Centre, as part of our commemorations for Remembrance. As a mark of respect to those who made the ultimate sacrifice, each class will lay a wreath of poppies at the memorial.

Each class will be visiting the memorial on a different day:

- **6H** will visit on the afternoon of **Tuesday 6th November**
- **6J** will visit on the afternoon of **Wednesday 7th November**
- **6S** will visit on the afternoon of **Thursday 8th November**



In class, the children will be using the 'Debt of Honour' register on the Commonwealth War Graves Commission's website (www.cwgc.org) in order to find out about the people whose names are recorded on our memorial. On the day of their visit, the children will also be making observational drawings.

We will be leaving school at 1.15 pm. each afternoon and returning to school by 3.00 p.m. As these visits will be weather dependent, it may be necessary to change the afternoon on which a class visits. However, you will be advised in advance if this is necessary. The children will need to bring a waterproof coat on the day of their visit.

As we already have permission for your child to walk when on an off-site visit in the local community, you only need to complete the slip below if you are able to assist with your child's class visit, and have a DBS check, by **Friday 19th October**.
