**Year 4 Residential Trip: 27<sup>th</sup> April to 29<sup>th</sup> April 2026**

Thank you to all of you that attended the initial parents meeting on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> September. We appreciate that some parents were unable to make the meeting; below are some details and the meeting power point is on our website [here](#)

Year 4 will be visiting Osmington Bay; which is a PGL site and a virtual tour is available on their [website](#). The setting is great and this will be our fourth visit, it has access to the beach where the children can take part in supervised activities. The centre is an approved HCC site.

During their stay children will have the opportunity to participate in a programme of outdoor study, which will enrich the term's Science and Geography topics. In addition, the residential experience will provide the children with the chance to develop their social skills, as well as having a positive effect upon their self-esteem, self-confidence and team work.

The estimated cost of the trip will be approx £300 based on 90\* children participating, this includes the coach travel, all food (except a packed lunch on the first day), accommodation and activities.
