



Bikeability - w/c 2nd March 2026

Final preparations are being made for Year 6 Bikeability next week. In order to keep everyone safe and avoid congestion the children must:-

- **Wear their cycle helmets** when on their bikes (it would be helpful to have these named please)
- **Dismount from their bike when entering the school** site and walk it to the back playground, which can be accessed via the service road between the Infant and Junior Schools. Children must be incredibly sensible as there may still be Infant parents and children waiting between our two schools.
- Show care and consideration when bringing their bikes into school, especially on the pavements.
- Park their bike along the fences on the back playground carefully. There will be signs showing where classes should park their bikes. If they have a lock, please make sure they know the combination or have a spare key (we have had problems with lost keys in the past!).
- Bring a carrier bag to keep their seat dry whilst their bike is not being used, in case it rains.
- Year 6 **will not** have PE on Monday
- Children will need to wear school uniform all week, however they should have **suitable clothes** (including a waterproof coat) and footwear (children can wear their trainers to school all week) as the course takes place in all weathers. **Girls can bring leggings to change into.**
- **If your child keeps an Inhaler, EpiPen or own plasters in school**, please send a small bag suitable for them to take out on their bikes, or ensure they have a coat with a zip/secure pocket that this item/s will fit into, as they will be responsible for it when they go out on the road sessions.
- Kindly note that all bicycles must be taken home at the end of each day; however they can be dropped off and collected outside of the school day between 7.30am and 6pm if that helps (please just let us know).

Fingers crossed the weather is dry (unfortunately we have no choice regarding the Bikeability dates)!
