With Year 6 SATs less than three weeks away, we are planning to offer **Year 6 SATs 'Chill and Chat' breakfast** before school during the test week again this year. Details of the national test timetable can be found [here](#)

<b>When?</b>	<b>Monday 11<sup>th</sup> – Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> May (SATS Week)</b>
<b>Where?</b>	<b>The school hall</b> (via Back Hall doors)
<b>Time?</b>	<b>8.15am</b> (they will then have 5 minutes outside before going to class at 8.40am)

The children will have the opportunity to...

- Sit and chat with their friends
- Bring their own breakfast\* or help themselves to cereal, yoghurt or fruit (no charge)
- Ask the grown-ups if they have any questions or worries
- Be in school ready for the tests, having had a more relaxed start to their school day.

*Please remember:*

- **No nuts or nut related** products please including Nutella.
- Children may need a separate lunchbox which can then be left in their cubby hole.
- The breakfast must be healthy (and low in added sugar!).

This has worked really well over the last 2 years and was appreciated by the children and parents. Kindly note that participation is dependent upon good behaviour, including during the breakfast slots themselves.
