<b>Reception - British Summer</b> Ideas include: Pimm's, squash, wine, frisbees, reusable glasses and plates, pretty napkins, and garden games.	<b>Year 3 - Family Night In</b> Small board games, crisps, pizza vouchers, pizza trays, pasta sauces, cute mugs, sweets, wine, and chocolates
<b>Year 1 - Beach Day Ready</b> Beach toys, bats and balls, kites, reusable cups, funky towels, and snacks with a long shelf life.	<b>Year 4 - Kids' Summer Fun</b> Bubbles, water pistols, giant chalks, ice lolly moulds, balls, and smore kits
<b>Year 2 - Picnic Hamper</b> Picnic blankets, wine coolers, fancy drinks & biscuits, pretty napkins and plastic picnic plates & glasses	<b>Year 5 - World Cup Football</b> Face paint, flags, temporary tattoos, crisps, beer, soft drinks, and footballs.
