



Promoting Positive Behaviour - Our Reward Systems



At Heatherside, we have high expectations and believe that all our children should behave well and try their best in their learning. In order to support children in developing confidence, independence, resilience and enjoyment in their work alongside their positive behaviour towards each other and all members of the school community, we have a number of reward systems at school. No matter how old we are, it always makes us feel good about ourselves when someone says thank you, praises our efforts or recognises our achievements and we hope that all our systems will help all our children to flourish in our school.

Star Book



Any member of staff can nominate a child to go in our Star Book for making a positive contribution to our school. This might be for exceptional work or behaviour, representing the school well, being a good friend, consistent standards, tremendous effort, perseverance...whatever has made them a real star that week! In our Friday assembly, we share these achievements and children are awarded with their certificate. Our certificates also have a space to show what it has been awarded for.



HOUSE POINTS



All our children are in a House Team and can earn points towards the termly trophy and DVD afternoon. House Points tokens are used, which children have to post in the class jars and the weekly totals are shared on Fridays. House Points can be awarded for good work and behaviour, although we do expect our children to try their best without necessarily being rewarded every time. Children will be responsible for collecting their token from their teachers and putting in their house jar. Purple Headteacher House Points show special recognition and are worth 3 House Points!



STAMPS – GOING FOR GOLD!



This is an individual reward system, which enables children to challenge themselves and aim to achieve their Gold Certificate. Children have to achieve 10 stamps to achieve a Bronze sticker, a further 10 for Silver and a total of 30 for their Gold Certificate. The stickers will be presented in assembly. Stamps will be awarded for mainly for work and will reflect each child's own level of effort, attainment and progress. We hope that all our children will aspire to achieve their Gold Certificate by July and maybe even a Purple Medal which is awarded for 50 Stamps.

100 SQUARE



This is a class reward system which is designed to promote good co-operation, behaviour and hard work; helping children to feel a sense of belonging in their class and taking responsibility for their own actions and attitude as part of a class group. A maximum of one tick per lesson can be achieved and when the class has achieved 100 ticks, they are allowed to choose a class treat from a list of agreed rewards.
