Macbeth Performance – Wednesday 27th September

In Year 5, we are really excited to be welcoming the Young Shakespeare Company to the school on **Wednesday 27th September**. They will be putting on a performance of Macbeth, which in previous years has been a thoroughly enjoyable, interactive experience for the children. This will form part of our English unit; the children will use the performance as a stimulus for their own drama and written work based on Macbeth.

The performance, which is being held in the school hall, starts at 1:10pm and finishes at **3:05pm**. **Please note that this will mean that Year 5 will be out slightly later than usual on this particular day.**
