## Careful and considerate driving and parking

Please can we remind all parents to park with due care and consideration to our local neighbours and residents if you are using your car on the school run. We have received complaints in the last week from people who live nearby and who have had their drive ways partially or completely blocked. We have [attached a leaflet](#) which was sent to us last week from Hampshire's Travel Planning Team as they have also received complaints from local residents.

We do understand that it is difficult to find somewhere safe and nearby to park, which is why we encourage as many families as possible to walk, scoot or 'park and stride' in a road a little further away and walk the last bit.

It is really important to us that we have positive relationships with our neighbours and it does not reflect well on our schools when parents park in ways which are dangerous, illegal or inconsiderate.



Kindly note that there is no parent driving onto site for drop off or pick up, with the exception of Blue Badge (disabled) holders. There was some very dangerous driving in the car park this week and we need to do everything we can to keep our children safe.

Your understanding and support in this is vital.
