The 'Hart Think Safe' partnership has invited the children in Year 6 to participate in one of their **'Think Safe'** events that will be held at Building 10, Watchmoor Park, Camberley. This will take place on Wednesday 13th March. We apologise for the short notice but unfortunately Hart Council were only able to confirm that they had found a venue to host this event at the end of last week.

During their visit to the centre, the children will participate in a variety of 'Think Safe' workshops, such as fire safety, stranger danger, basic first aid and railway safety. These workshops will be led by representatives from local organisations such as the Hampshire Constabulary and Hampshire Fire and Rescue Service. The workshops are designed to develop children's skills in hazard awareness and risk management of everyday scenarios.

The children will depart school at 12.00 p.m. and return to school at approximately 3.10 p.m. As the children will be having an early lunch on the day of the visit, **your child will need to bring a packed lunch** to eat before they depart.
