Dear Parents

On behalf of everyone at Heatherside Junior School I would like to extend a very warm welcome to you and your family. We are delighted that you have chosen Heatherside for your child and look forward to getting to know them (and you) over the coming four years. We understand that the transfer to junior school might feel a little daunting (including for parents!) and so I am hoping that me being at the Infants last year will help their transition as I had the opportunity to get to know your child a little.

To help your child's move to Year 3 we have arranged three induction visits for your child, where they will have the opportunity to meet their teacher, join in some playground games and be shown around the school by one of our current Year 3s. These visits will take place on:

Friday 3 rd May	9.15 - 10.00	Years 2/3 Playground Games
Thursday 20 th June	9.15 - 10.45	(Guided Tour led by current Year 3s)
Thursday 4 th July	9.15 - 10.15	(Meet their Teacher)

Your child will be brought across from the Infants School and collected by their teacher on all of these occasions.

Our New Intake Evening for Parents will be held on **Tuesday 25th June at 7pm** and we hope very much that you will be able to come along. After a short presentation in the hall, where you will find out your child's class, you will then meet with your child's new teacher in their classroom. They will talk through some of the practical arrangements for September and how we will be supporting your child's transition. Uniform will be available to order on the evening, ready for collection at a later date.

You will have received your official 'Offer' of a place from Hampshire County Council on Tuesday 16th April and this year there is **an automatic acceptance system in place**. This means that if you no longer need the place at Heatherside Junior for September 2024, you need to inform Hampshire Admissions of this in writing via the following email admissions.team@hants.gov.uk Please could we ask that this is completed immediately if you no longer require the place so that places can be offered from our Waiting List which is established on 30th April.
