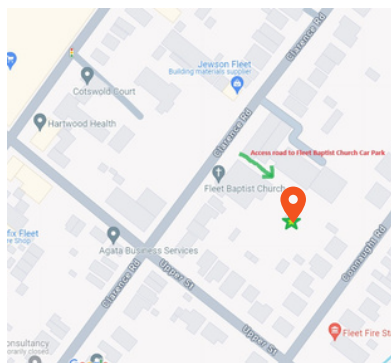

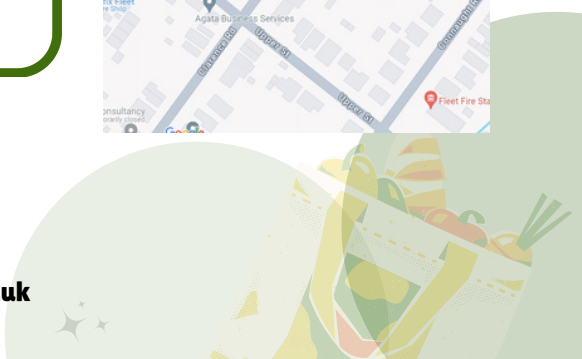

What is the difference between a Pantry and a Foodbank?

Pantry

- Provides support for anyone in need in the community.
- You can pick your own food items, (although the number of products may be limited to ensure the food is shared fairly).
- No referral required, just a membership form to be filled in on your first visit.
- There is no limit on how long a person may be a member of the Pantry.
- £5 membership fee is paid each time you visit, and you are guaranteed to receive at least £20-£30 worth of goods in return.

Foodbanks

- 3 days worth of food for emergency support of those in desperate need.
- The food is provided in pre selected packages so it is chosen for you.
- You need to have a referral from a supporting agency such as Citizen's Advice.
- Support is offered for a limited amount of time.
- The food parcels are free
